School Opening and Closing

The school will open to receive pupils at the hour of 9.05 am.

No responsibility is accepted for pupils arriving before that time. Classes will commence each day at 9.20 am.

School ends each day at 2pm (infants) and 3pm (1st-6th). Parents who wish to have their children escorted home should make their own arrangements to have them met at the end of the church wall and the person to escort them should be at the school not later than 2pm/3pm as the school cannot accept responsibility for looking after the children after that time.

We ask parents and children to leave promptly as not to disturb the residents living locally.

Standardised Testing

Standardised testing will be completed during the month of May. Standardised testing in Spellings, English and Maths takes place annually in classes 1st to 6th.

Standardised testing is one form of assessment used in schools. Many other forms of assessment are also used throughout the year. These include; teacher observation, child/parental feedback, self-assessment, work samples, projects, quizzes and weekly/termly tests. Standardised tests have many merits but do not measure many aspects of a child's learning and ability. Standardised tests do not measure resilience, creativity, critical thinking, self-discipline, social skills or motivation.

It is important that as parents and educators we do not allow our children to be defined by the results of test.
